



Henry Family Undergraduate Excellence Fund

Purpose: To support undergraduate students pursuing value-added, experiential opportunities such as internships, co-ops, field work, extended lab research projects and study abroad. The intent of this award is to help cover large expenses for students who demonstrate financial need and who would not be able to experience these opportunities otherwise. This award is for students who are looking for an experience that will advance their education at Mississippi State University and also their career.

Deadlines and travel periods:

Application Deadline

April 1
November 1

Travel Dates

May 15 – December 31
January 1 – May 15

Application Guidelines:

- The student must complete the required application.
- The student must turn in a recommendation letter with the application from the professor that is overseeing the opportunity.
- A student can receive only one award per year.

Academic and Financial Guidelines:

- Student must have filed FAFSA for the current academic year and must demonstrate financial need based on the FAFSA information.
- Must be at least an upcoming junior upon being awarded.
- Must have at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA.

Requirements Upon Return:

- Upon the student's return, the student must write a two-page essay describing the experience and how the opportunity will enhance their education and career.
- The student must handwrite a letter to the donor for funding the opportunity.
- The essay can be turned into the College of Arts & Sciences, along with a copy of the handwritten thank you note.

- All receipts and charges attained while traveling must be turned into the Dean's Office (eg., lodging, travel, food, etc.)

***These requirements must be fulfilled within two weeks of returning.

Miscellaneous Information:

- Awards will range from \$500-\$5,000
- Final decisions will be made by the College of Arts & Sciences Dean's Office. Funding decisions will be made within three weeks after the deadline. Students and their supporting professor(s) will receive an e-mail of award notification. Instructions for travel funding will be included.
